

Security rules for service provider

This appendix regulates the requirements that DB Schenker places on suppliers who regularly visits DB Schenker's units.

§1.

The supplier shall sign a DB Schenker access card when he / she, and without supervision, will perform tasks in DB Schenker's premises. The access card must be carried visibly by the supplier at all visits.

§2.

Before an access card can be signed the supplier must ensure that their employees who are on assignment at DB Schenker's premises have the necessary training, skills and competencies. This is done by contacting the current representative at DB Schenker, who informs which trainings are required for the work to be performed.

The supplier is also responsible for the fact that hired staff and/or contractors who themselves are to carry out tasks with their own access rights to our premises are background checked, for example in criminal records. Convictions relating to serious crimes may affect the performance or be disqualifying for the assignment with Schenker and is also an AEO-requirement.

§3.

The supplier undertakes to use only labor that has a residence-/work permit.

§4.

The supplier may not, without contacting the representative of DB Schenker, use subcontractors. The same regulations for own access in DB Schenker's premises apply to the supplier's subcontractor.

§5.

The Parties undertake to observe caution and confidentiality regarding company confidential information and contractual competition information such as prices etc.
